JEREMIAH AFAAYO

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Proverbs 18:10 NKJV

The name of the Lord is a strong tower; The righteous run to it and are safe.

CHRIST IN YOU

Colossians 1:27 NKJV

To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.

For a long time in my life, I had this question: “If I have the fruits of the Holy Spirit such as love, joy, peace and self control, then why do I feel like I am lacking in them at certain times?”

Until I read our theme verse, and my eyes were opened to this mystery. Christ in me, floods me with the expectation of his glory. This expectation is called hope and Romans 5:5 assures us that hope does not disappoint. Day by day, we are transformed into His image, by the Holy Spirit who dwells in us. Christ in me doesn't mean I will be perfect. It means I am moving towards perfection.

I may be pressed but I won't be crushed because of the hope Jesus brings in me. As a child of God, quitting is not an option.

Prayer

OVERCOMING FEAR

II Timothy 1:7 NKJV

For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

When God tells us not to bow to any other god but Him, our minds run to things like worshiping of graven images. But did you know that fear is a god you could be bowing to.

Many of us have missed great opportunities to advance the kingdom of God because of bowing to fear. This is because we believe in Jesus as savior and not as Lord. If someone is your Lord, you do whatever they tell you to do with no questions asked. When the Bible says that there is no fear in love, it means you are to love God with the Agape love which is sacrificial. This means in spite of your urges to cower back in fear; you will choose to move in faith sacrificially.

When you get into a situation that causes you to fear, remind yourself that you will not bow to any other god apart from Jehovah Himself.

Prayer

Romans 3:4 NKJV

Certainly not! Indeed, let God be true but every man a liar. As it is written: "That You may be justified in Your words, And may overcome when You are judged."

Our theme scripture teaches us that, even if every man lies, God will still be true.

The Bible says that God is not a son of man to lie or to change His mind. Many times, we tend to listen and believe people's words more than we do God's word. For example, we believe that it is normal that everyone should fall sick, yet God says that of the people of Zion no one will say am sick. (Isaiah 33:24) Our duty is submitting to God's word and resist the devil, and he will flee from us. (James 4:7)

Child of God, before you believe in anybody's say or report, first know God's say. If God says that you will not borrow but rather you will lend to nations, let no man convince you that you are poor. Move by what you know of your God, not what the world says.

Prayer

Loving father, I thank you for your word. I am fully convinced that all you promised me is true. I refuse to live and move as the world does and choose what you have said.

TRUST IN THE LORD

Proverbs 3:5-6 NKJV

Trust in the LORD with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths.

Our scripture today instructs us to trust in the Lord with all our hearts, and He will direct our paths.

The Bible says that anyone who trusts in Him will never be put to shame. (Romans 10:11) Trusting God for something while having a plan B at the same time is not what Paul is talking about here. God wants us to lean on Him entirely and to have confidence in His word.

As children of God, we must always recognize God as our only hope if He is to direct our paths. Our ways may seem right in the moment and yet they lead to death. (Proverbs 16:25) On the other hand, God's way always leads to life.

1 Corinthians 13:4 NLT

Kindness should not only be shown to the people you know, but it should also be extended to whoever comes your way. The widow who only had a handful of flour, used it to feed Elijah first, who was even a stranger to her. And in return, God blessed her bountifully. Child of God, we must make the sacrificial decision to be kind always. Don't minimize the smallest acts of kindness for they can go a long way.

If you want to have a happy life, be kind. The message version puts it like this, “You’re blessed when you care. At the moment of being ‘care-full,’ you find yourselves cared for. (Mathew 5:7) Choose to always show kindness to everyone regardless of their age or social status.

LOVE DOES NOT ENVY

1 Corinthians 13:4 NKJV

Love suffers long and is kind; love does not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up;

One of the major factors that caused the Pharisees to crucify Jesus was envy. They were discontented seeing someone other than them succeed in any way. Needless to say, envy is one of the biggest problems in our day.

Our theme scripture points out that love does not envy. Rather it rejoices when others succeed. At the root of envy is often discontentment. Contentment comes from having an inward confidence based on the sufficiency of God. Child of God, you and I are parts of one body in Christ. If one part is honored, we should all rejoice with it. (1 Corinthians 12:26)

We have far more interesting things to do with our lives than compare ourselves with each other. When we choose to honor each other, we find ourselves proud owners of everything that can't be bought.

Prayer

Loving father, we thank you for your word. Make us content with You and remind us that Your presence is all we need. I will not envy others because You are my shepherd and therefore, I lack nothing.

GO DEEPER

Luke 5:4 NKJV

When He had stopped speaking, He said to Simon, "Launch out into the deep and let down your nets for a catch."

In our theme scripture today, Simon and his friends had tried the whole night but failed to catch any fish. This went on until Jesus told them to launch deeper.

There are victories you will never experience in life until you go an extra mile. Be it in education, business or ministry. You have to get comfortable with being uncomfortable and launch deeper into the things of God.

Probably you're not receiving the answers for that prayer because you are shallow regarding the reasons for why you want that thing. Deep calls unto deep. The deeper you immerse yourself into God's word, the more your eyes will open regarding what you are praying for.

James 1:17 NKJV

Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows.

Our theme verse speaks of a good and perfect gift, which in this case is the Holy spirit. He is given to whoever believes in Jesus Christ but for Him to work in you, you must be conscious of his availability and power!

To be conscious is to have knowledge of something. Do you know that the Holy Spirit is your guide, strengthener, comforter, counselor and standby just in case you need anything else. (John 14:16 AMP) You can live as a light to others because the Holy Spirit in you gives you power, love and a sound mind. (2 Timothy 1:7)

Child of God, just as God does not change, the Holy Spirit does not change too. Walk in boldness knowing that the Holy Spirit and His abilities are always at work in you.

1 John 4:18 NIV

2 Corinthians 12:9-10 NIV

Instead of trying to look to yourself or the world for confidence, self-control, kindness and love, look to the Holy Spirit in you who is a guarantee that you have all these and much more. Focus on the truth that all things are working together for your good, think about how you are fearfully and wonderfully made, how you are the righteousness of God, how you are rich in Christ Jesus your hope of glory.

When you think such thoughts, you gain a confidence in God that keeps you steady on your feet. You will be beholding the glorious image of God while at the same time being transformed into the same image.

Prayer prompt

Take time to ask God, through His Spirit, to help you meditate on His word. Ask Him to enable you to put your trust in Him always.

WE ARE HERE TO SERVE

John 13:14 AMP

If I then, your Lord and Teacher (Master), have washed your feet, you ought [it is your duty, you are under obligation, you owe it] to wash one another's feet.

One of the key attributes that differentiate a leader from a boss is servant hood. Anyone can boss people around, but an attitude of service is what makes a leader.

Many people who eventually rose to greatness were not driven by a desire to be great but a desire to serve. Servant hood does not mean thinking less of yourself, it is thinking of yourself less. One of the greatest ways to show gratitude to God for all He has done for you is by serving others. You might be a secretary, teacher, doctor or preacher. What is important is that you do it with an attitude of service. A servant seeks ways to help others. This is because when we serve others, we are serving Jesus Himself. When we give of our time and resources to others we are giving to Jesus Himself and Jesus rewards servant hood (Mathew 25:35-40). We know that we are not saved by good works but we are saved to do good works. In the same way, we are not saved by serving but we are saved to serve others.

You can choose to be a taker, always letting other people serve you or you can choose to see what God can do through you when you serve others.

Prayer prompt

Take time to ask God who you can serve today and how you can serve better.

JESUS IN YOUR BROKENNESS

Hosea 6:1 NLT

"Come, let us return to the LORD! He has torn us in pieces; now he will heal us. He has injured us; now he will bandage our wounds.

We normally view brokenness as a bad thing but sometimes it's for our own good. Some breaking is done by God because some things in our lives need to be broken so that better things can be built.

Some things that need to be broken include our will, pride and strongholds we've built. These things limit us from attaining the great things God has prepared for us. God therefore breaks us so that He can build humility, gratitude and a dependence on God. When you are going through a season of breakdown, your prayer should be 'Lord, what are you trying to teach me?' When Jesus was on the cross, His relationship with God was broken so that our relationship with God would be restored.

We can therefore be excited in times of breakdown because we know that times of restoration are just a breath away.

Prayer prompt

Take time and thank God for seasons in which He breaks you so that He can build something much better. Ask Him to open your eyes to see what He is teaching you in every circumstance.

THE HIGHEST FORM OF SPIRITUAL WARFARE

1 Peter 4:8 AMP

Above all things have intense and unfailing love for one another, for love covers a multitude of sins [forgives and disregards the offenses of others].

Pat Barrett describes love as a beautiful garden that's bursting with color when tended with care. In other words, love takes effort.

Love is going to cost you something. It could be your time, pride or selfishness. If we are to love like God, we have to love without expecting anything in return. Remember Jesus died for us while we were of no use whatsoever to Him. We might have problems we are dealing with ourselves but the answers to our problems are found in choosing to forget ourselves and start living to make other people's lives better. The highest form of spiritual warfare we can use is love because it never fails. (1 Corinthians 13:8)

If we are to love, we have to forgive and disregard other people's offenses because those will always be there. Choose to believe in love for it always wins.

Prayer prompt

Take time to ask God to let His love flow through you to others. Ask Him to enable you walk in love no matter the circumstance.

FEAR NOT

Isaiah 41:10 NLT

Don't be afraid, for I am with you. Do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you. I will help you. I will uphold you with my victorious right hand.

One thing we must be conscious about are the enemies of faith. One of these enemies is the tongue.

In Luke 1, God made Zacharias unable to speak because He knew Zacharias' unbelief would cause him to say words that would hinder him from seeing the miracle God promised him. Another enemy is the inner voice saying negative things such as "you will never get well, or you are too far gone." Realize that this is the devil coming after your faith. In the face of negativity, reply by boldly declaring the truth of God's word over your life. In Mark 9:17-29, Jesus faced a situation which was a faith shaker. A father brought his son who had been possessed by a demon. The demon in the boy tried to shake Jesus' faith by throwing him down violently and making him appear as if he were dead. Jesus wasn't shaken because He knew that faith is what affirms and ensures that what is hoped for will come to pass. As you dwell in prayer and the word, you will become spiritually conscious so that you can overcome anything that comes against your faith.

When you overcome temptations and trials your faith gets strengthened and you are filled with an inexpressible and glorious joy because you have witnessed your soul being victorious.

Prayer prompt

Take time to ask God to help you in the face of doubt and temptation, to choose His will over your own.

THE POWER OF PRAYER

Philippians 4:6 NKJV

Do not be anxious about anything but with prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.

In a world that is so unpredictable, it is easy to get caught up in the anxiety and stress brought about by the fluctuating prices, job instability and debt.

But this doesn't have to be your story. In the Bible we see how God provided for Elijah during the 3 years of drought in Israel. God used ravens to bring him food in the morning and in the evening. Even when Elijah had to go somewhere else, God still provided for him. Elijah trusted in God and God never failed him. We do not have a way to stop ourselves from worrying but when we let God be God by choosing to bring all our worries to Him through prayer, the worries lose their power. The secret Elijah had was that he was a man of faith as we see in 1 Kings 18:41 where he tells Ahab of the sound of abundance of rain yet in reality there was no sign of rain. We too, like Elijah, can choose to live above the negative signs all around and declare increase every single day.

Don't discount the power of a prayer coupled with faith. Your prayers matter. Revelation 5 says our prayers are in golden bowls in heaven and just like gold is precious our prayers are also precious.

Prayer prompt

Take time to thank God for the gift of prayer. Ask Him to enable you trust and believe that all things are possible in His name.

WAIT ON THE LORD

Psalms 40:1-2 NKJV

I waited patiently for the LORD. and he inclined unto me, and heard my cry. He brought me up also out of an horrible pit. out of the miry clay. and set my feet upon a rock, and established my goings.

Many at times things don't work out the way we hoped. Our plans fail; visions fade. Maybe you thought you would be married by now or maybe you thought your business should have taken off by now or you were betrayed by those you trusted. But when in such situations where do you get your strength from.

The Bible talks of a man called David in 1 Samuel 30 who came back home one day only to find that his enemies had burnt down the city and taken as captives his family and the families of his soldiers. This was a huge blow to David as even his men turned on him. But the Bible tells us that in this moment when his world had turned upside down, David strengthened himself in the Lord. David knew in his heart that even if everything looked like it was failing, all he had to do was hide himself in the Lord with firm footed devotion. "The Hebrew word for waiting is qavah which means to be entwined with. David knew the secret that when you stick with God, He turns the mourning to dancing and the sorrow to joy.

I want to encourage you today that no matter the circumstances, lean on the Lord. Let your hope be anchored in Him. As you do this you will find that He will give you beauty for ashes and your strength will be renewed.

Prayer prompt

Take time to ask God to enable you to choose to wait on Him in all circumstances. Ask Him to incline your heart to His that you may believe Him without wavering.

A CONTENTED HEART

1 Timothy 6:6 KJV

But godliness with contentment is great gain.

In this world there will always be “better.” But God’s desire for us is not to build our lives on the pursuit of better but rather on contentment.

Adam and Eve thought they knew better than God and so they fell to the lust of the flesh, lust of the eyes and the pride of life. Jesus on the other hand was able to overcome these three things when He was tempted by Satan in the desert. Using the word of God, He was able to remain content. We already have better right in front of us, but because of comparison we miss out on the blessings God has availed for us. We should not be like the Pharisees who missed out on Jesus because they were looking for better.

God has already done so much for us, we are forgiven, set free, anointed and redeemed. We can rejoice because it’s already better!

Prayer prompt

Take time to thank God for all that He has already done for you. Ask Him to enable you be content because He has already given you everything you need.

GOD MY HELPER

Psalm 121:1-2 NKJV

I will lift up my eyes to the hills—From whence comes my help? My help comes from the LORD, Who made heaven and earth.

There is a great spiritual battle for the souls of people. The enemy wants to silence every believer whether you have just given your life to Christ, or you have been walking with Jesus for a while.

He may come to you with the lie that the darkness will not end, so you might just as well stop singing. This is when you declare the word of God that promises that night tears end, and joy comes (Psalm 30:5). If you are leading people to Jesus, or if you are walking in the will of God expect push backs from the enemy. Paul and Silas were thrown into prison because they rebuked a demon out of a slave girl. Even in prison, they did not keep silent. They prayed and sung to God because they knew that they were born of God and were therefore one step closer to victory.

When you are faced with the temptation to fear, stand firm in the glory Christ gave you and remember that God is with you and your help has come.

Prayer prompt

Take time to thank God for always being with you. Declare that you will not fear though the mountains shake for He alone is your refuge and strength. Ask Him to enable you trust and know that all the darkness bows down to Him.

GOD WANTS YOU SEATED

Ephesians 2:6 NIV

And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus,

When a baby is growing up, they first have to learn how to sit before they can stand or walk. The same applies to us in our spiritual journey as children of God. Before you desire to go out and do things for God have you learnt how to sit in God?

By this I mean, have you believed in the finished works of Jesus; that everything you need has already been provided (Phil. 4:19), that your healing was already given (1 Pet. 2:24), that all things are working for your good (Romans 8:28), that God will perfect that concerns you (Psalm 138:8). These and so many others are promises and truths that God gave us to rid us of striving and losing our peace over things He has already achieved for us. With this truth embedded in you, you don't give to be blessed, you give because you know that you are already blessed. You don't do spiritual warfare to defeat the devil; you do spiritual warfare because you know the devil has already been defeated.

When you are seated in Christ, you will always be a victor because you will not approach challenges to gain victory, but you will know that the victory is already yours!

Prayer prompt

Take time to thank God for all the wonderful things He has already achieved for you. Ask Him to enable you not to strive for you are already a victor in Him.

WEAKNESS TURNED INTO STRENGTH

Isaiah 61:3 NLT

To all who mourn in Israel, he will give a crown of beauty for ashes, a joyous blessing instead of mourning, festive praise instead of despair. In their righteousness, they will be like great oaks that the Lord has planted for his own glory.

I am naturally a perfectionist. For a long time, I begged God to take perfectionism away from me until I realized our God can use anything for His glory. So now I boast about my weaknesses for they create a platform for God's grace to be manifested in my life.

Even from the Bible, Joseph being sold as slave was a bad thing and yet it was the very thing that God used to put him on the path of being a mighty man. Jesus' disciples were devastated when they saw their master on the cross and yet His crucifixion would be the very thing they would later boast about as the reason for their salvation. That's why the psalmist says, "I will fear no evil because you are with me. When faced with scary moments, we need to remember we have a God who turns graves into gardens.

Rejoice in the truth that the thing that was designed to keep you out is the very thing God is going to use to take you into His rich and wonderful promises.

Prayer

Thank you God, for I know with you, my weaknesses are strengths, and your grace will always be enough for me.

COVERED

Ephesians 2:4-5 NKJV

But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved),

One of the tactics the enemy uses is to amplify the self-critical voices within us. As a result, every time you do or say something you regret, you immediately condemn yourself to be buried six feet beneath the ground.

But thanks be to God for His words of love with which He reassures us and sets us on firm ground. It's His word of love that reminds you that He will make no mention of your past sins or even recall them. (Zephaniah 3:17 AMP) and that there is no condemnation to those of us who are in Christ Jesus (Romans 8:1). And if you ever think that there is something you will do that His love cannot cover, He reminds you that there is grace to spare for all your mistakes (Ephesians 2:7).

So today, meditate on His great love for you, and see him take away that self condemnation from you so that you can be free to lift your hands in gratitude for what He has done for you.

Prayer

Loving father, thank you for your grace that is abundant and for your mercies that are new every morning. I let go of my fear and receive your love today.

TRUST IN GOD

Psalms 118:8 TPT

Lord, it is so much better to trust in you to save me than to put my confidence in someone else.

Trusting God is about having confidence in the truth that God's plan for you is good even when the situation looks otherwise.

When in the garden of Gethsemane, Jesus had to trust His Father's plan above what His flesh wanted. Even though He wanted the cup of suffering to be taken away, He submitted to God all the way. Trust in God has to be manifested in your thoughts and in the words you speak. Philemon 1:6 says, "the communication of your faith becomes effectual by the acknowledging of every good thing which is in you in Christ Jesus". Paul and Silas demonstrated this when they sung praises to God while in prison. Trusting God could also be described as getting out of the boat and walking on the water even when everyone else says otherwise. It's putting all your hope in Jesus. The Bible says we walk by faith and not by sight. Playing it safe robs us of an opportunity for us to see God moving in a mighty way on our behalf.

Today, surrender that troubling situation in your life to God because He is the only one with the power to never fail you.

Prayer

Loving father, I trust you above my ability to handle my finances, loved ones, or myself. You know the end from the beginning, and I confidently trust that you will handle it.

SET APART

Romans 12:2 NIV

Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.

God really loves us, more than we could ever know. He loves us to the point that He even gave His son's life for us. Therefore, when He tells us to stay away from certain things and lay our lives for Him, it's for our own good.

Contrary to the world, He requires us to speak the truth in love, rebuking where necessary, not afraid of displeasing some because Jesus said 'woe to you when all men speak well of you' Luke 6:26. The world may think we are old fashioned but we do not live by the law of the world, we live by a higher law, the law of love. In this law, we are always looking for ways of being more forgiving, tender-hearted, kind and compassionate even in the smallest things.

Today, look around, someone needs a word of encouragement or simply a listening ear that you can give. Remember, whenever you live selflessly, you bring out the God colors in you to shine in a dark world.

Prayer

Heavenly father, thank you for having set me apart. Thank you for your grace that enables me to live a life that honors you through my interactions and selfless actions.

YOU ARE RICH

Romans 8:17 NIV

Now if we are children, then we are heirs—heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory.

In the story of the prodigal son, the older son refused to celebrate the return of His younger brother because he thought he was not as favored as his younger brother in the eyes of His father. The father simply reassured him that everything he owned also belonged to him as his son.

Likewise, as God's children, everything that is His is also ours. That includes His glory and dignity, His holiness and righteousness, His name and authority, His discipline and correction. What's more He has given us a relationship with Him that is intimate and secure. We can come to God's throne anytime, any day, anywhere with anything. We have the Holy Spirit who intercedes for us before the Father and gives us assurance that we truly belong to God.

This should give you reason to praise and worship God for the great and rich inheritance He has given you.

Prayer

Loving father, I am overwhelmed by your great love for me. Open my eyes to see the great riches you have bestowed upon me and may I walk in them with a heart of gratitude.

SPEND TIME WITH GOD

Psalm 27:4 AMPC

One thing have I asked of the Lord, that will I seek, inquire for, and [insistently] require: that I may dwell in the house of the Lord [in His presence] all the days of my life, to behold and gaze upon the beauty [the sweet attractiveness and the delightful loveliness] of the Lord and to meditate, consider, and inquire in His temple.

God wants us to seek Him daily through prayer, praise and worship and reading the word. Just like tithing, giving God the first portion of our time shows that we know He is our source.

You need to earnestly seek God if you are going to be able to enjoy your life even in hard times. This is because He gives you peace that passes all understanding and infuses you with strength when your strength is long gone. Through His word, God promises that those who seek Him will be protected (Psalm 91:1), receive direction (Psalm 73:24) and find true satisfaction (Psalm 17:15). You should not seek God just to appease him or because of legalism or because you need something from him. You should seek Him because you absolutely cannot do without Him.

Seeking God may require you to wake up early and let go of some things in your life to make time for God. No matter the sacrifice, spending time with God is worth it all.

Prayer

Heavenly father, thank you for the opportunity to seek you everyday. May I desire more than anything to seek you with all my heart for in you is all I need.

CHOOSE HUMILITY

Matthew 5:5 AMP

“Blessed [inwardly peaceful, spiritually secure, worthy of respect] are the gentle [the kind-hearted, the sweet-spirited, the self-controlled], for they will inherit the earth.

Humility is often undervalued and misinterpreted with being weak. On the contrary though, humility is a strength and a Godly virtue that was clear in the life of our master Jesus.

Humility is about sacrifice and deep concern for others. Humble people do not have pride but instead possess Godly confidence. Pride says, I am better than you while Godly confidence says, what I have has been given to me by God. We should yearn for humility because it brings about wisdom (Proverbs 11:2), God’s favor (James 4:6) and unity (Ephesians 4:2-3).

You can embrace humility today by listening more than you speak, showing gratitude and apologizing even for the little things.

Prayer

Lord Jesus Christ, I want to be more like You and less like me. I want to carry the mind you have that made you leave all of heaven’s glory to become human and die to save us. Give me a heart that has genuine concern for others.

GOOD AND TRUE FRIENDSHIPS

Ecclesiastes 4:9-10 NIV

Two are better than one, because they have a good return for their labor: If either of them falls down, one can help the other up. But pity anyone who falls and has no one to help them up.

Friendships are very crucial for a healthy Christian life. Without advice from a good friend, there is no safety (Proverbs 24:6). A good friend is one who can sharpen you in speech, love, conduct and Godly character. True friendship is about making sacrifices and speaking the truth in love.

Vulnerability is crucial because it is the key to real and authentic friendships. We should always confess what we are going through to one another because that is how we get healed (James 5:16). We are to desire and seek friends who sharpen us to be more patient, kind, humble and God fearing while also offering the same light to others. (Proverbs 27:17)

Today, show yourself friendly by stopping to have a conversation with someone or giving a helping hand.

Prayer

Loving Father, thank you for the gift of friends. Open my eyes to see opportunities in which I can influence my friends for your Kingdom. I believe to have purposeful and authentic friendships.

A HIGHER REST

Mark 6:31 NLT

Then Jesus said, “Let’s go off by ourselves to a quiet place and rest awhile.” He said this because there were so many people coming and going that Jesus and his apostles didn’t even have time to eat.

In our theme text, the disciples had just finished the assignment Jesus had given them in which they had gone out in pairs to preach the good news. They were tired and even Jesus recognized that they needed rest. Jesus therefore invites them to go away with Him to rest. Note that He didn’t send them away from Him but told them to go away with Him.

When we rest by spending time with God in prayer and meditation on His word, He gives us a joy and peace that is better and brighter than what we ever knew. God’s kind of rest makes us live continually refreshed because we rest in His ability to turn any situation around for our good.

Prayer:

Lord Jesus Christ, thank you for your rest. I can rest in you because you are a good father who cares for me more than I know. I believe that you will perfect everything that concerns me.

TAKE UP YOUR SPACE

Genesis 1:26 NIV

Then God said, “Let us make mankind in our image, in our likeness, so that they may rule over the fish in the sea and the birds in the sky, over the livestock and all the wild animals, and over all the creatures that move along the ground.”

God's desire for us is to have dominion on the earth. The Greek word for the word dominion also means kingdom. Therefore, whenever we pray that "your Kingdom come", what we are saying is; Lord help us take up our space.

Taking up our space is about keeping a standard. Just like a father gives a standard that is to be kept in his home, we too are to set the standard for the world. For us Christians, Jesus has set the standard, and our job is to keep it. We have to imitate Him in love, speech and conduct.

We have to live lives that are self controlled, not being people pleasers by trying to do everything but rather emulating our savior who walked with wisdom and grace. Hallelujah!

Prayer:

Loving Father, thank you for giving me dominion to rule on the earth. May I not be conformed to the standards of this world but rather walk in your ways.

GIVE THANKS

Psalms 103:2 NIV

Praise the Lord, my soul, and forget not all his benefits—

Our daily desire as God's redeemed children should be to live in remembrance of what God has done for us. We should constantly remind ourselves of the hope, freedom, love and grace we received in Jesus. Remembering what God has done for us keeps us fueled and aflame.

It should never roll off our backs casually that all our sins have already been forgiven (Romans 3:24). We should never lose sight of God's immense love towards us that ensures that we always have the grace needed to abound to every good work. (2 Corinthians 9:8)

We should use any opportunity we get to thank God. His will is for us to give thanks in everything and as a result, we will find ourselves more grateful day by day.

Prayer

Dear Lord Jesus Christ, thank you for blessing me with everything I need. Awaken my conscious to be grateful for all that you do for me.

FIGHT FOR YOUR IDENTITY

2 Timothy 1:7 NIV, For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline.

From our theme scripture, we see that God has given you and I an identity as powerful, loving and self-disciplined children of God.

The challenge we often fall prey to is the Esau syndrome. Just as Esau traded his birthright for some stew (Genesis 25:29), we too often trade our identity to satisfy our temporary feelings and desires. When faced with a challenge, we feel fear and so to satisfy this feeling, we label ourselves as incompetent. What we need to do is stand our ground and fight for our identity because the feeling of insufficiency or fear is momentary while our identity as a loving people is eternal.

Keeping close connection with the word and the Holy Spirit will help us in this fight because they will always confirm our identity to us.

Prayer:

Loving Father, thank you for giving me an identity as your child. Today I receive the grace to fight for my identity and stand my ground no matter the temptation I may face.

FIGHT FOR YOUR IDENTITY 2

2 Corinthians 5:7 NIV

For we live by faith, not by sight.

Life's challenges will shake us more in areas of our lives where we haven't embraced what God says about us.

One truth that we need to meditate upon often is that our Identity is not determined by our current circumstances or feelings. It doesn't matter whether you currently feel condemned, your identity as one with no condemnation doesn't change. (Romans 8:1). You might feel perplexed about a particular decision you have to make, that doesn't change the fact that you have access to all of heaven's wisdom. (1 Corinthians 1:30)

Our Identity in Christ is a finished work. It was achieved for us at the cross. We should therefore stop trying to achieve something that has already been achieved for us. All you and I have to do is live in this newness of life by walking in the Spirit (Galatians 5:16).

Prayer:

King of Glory, thank you for the gift of identity that I have in you. I walk like one who has been given everything. May your Holy Spirit continue reminding and revealing to me all things concerning who I am in Christ Jesus.

BEAUTY FROM PAIN

2 Corinthians 4:17 NIV

For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all.

I love a famous quote from Abraham Lincoln which says, " We can complain because rosebushes have thorns, or we can rejoice that thornbushes have roses."

Just like the thorns on roses have a purpose of protecting the rose from predators, God also has a purpose for the thorns in our life. We should stop trying to always get rid of all our thorns because they play an important role. First, they help keep a check on our egos (2 Corinthians 12:7). Secondly, thorns help us trust God's Grace to be sufficient because they create a platform for God's power to be manifested in our lives.

We can rejoice during trials because just as pressure brings forth diamond, even so tests produce perseverance in us.

Prayer

Loving Father, I thank you for you have a plan for each thorn in my life. May I stand strong knowing that in everything, you are working for my good.

A REASON FOR LIVING

Matthew 6:33 NIV

But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.

The teacher in Ecclesiastes speaks of a life that is ultimately focused on toiling, leaving a legacy, acquiring knowledge and pleasure as being utterly meaningless.

Jesus also emphasizes that these things should never be what our lives are all about (Matthew 6:25). Our lives are supposed to be about seeking the kingdom of God and His way of being right. One of the ways we seek the kingdom is through our words. Our speech should build us. This is why we should pray in tongues often for he who prays in tongues builds himself up (Jude 1:20).

We should also speak words of victory over ourselves and others. We have to be intentional about declaring the good things we have in Jesus for then do we fulfill our duty as ministers of Grace. (Ephesians 4:29)

Prayer

King of Glory, thank you for showing me what life is all about. May my speech always reflect heaven as I speak life in all circumstances.

A REASON FOR LIVING 2

2 Corinthians 3:6 NIV

He has made us competent as ministers of a new covenant—not of the letter but of the Spirit; for the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life.

Our theme verse speaks of believers being ministers of a new covenant. The new covenant is described in Jeremiah 31:31-34 and it is mainly composed of two things.

First is that God's law will be on our hearts and minds. We are now able to live Holy lives, not by following a set of rules which reveal sin and demand obedience which in turn leads to death because man is powerless over sin. Instead, we now depend on the power of the Holy Spirit living in us to produce fruit that remains. Secondly, in the new covenant, our sins will be remembered NO more. We see this through how God keeps giving us Grace by always extending the day of salvation to today (2 Corinthians 6:2).

You and I have now been called to minister this covenant to ourselves and to others through the way we live. Whenever we feel incompetent to do so, we can always approach God's throne boldly through prayer and meditation on His word to find the divine enablement we need.

John 4:24 NKJV

Matthew 4:16 NASB

Our theme scripture tells us of the people who lived in darkness before the Christ. But when Christ came, He Redeemed them and so they saw the light.

The coming of Jesus changed everything on and in this world, He gave light and life to us who He drew out of the darkness by His grace. This light delivered us from sin and death, we are no longer debtors to a sinful life, but to salvation, He gave us a new life and a new Name. Hebrews 12:1 NIV

Paul was able to overcome the thorn in his flesh only when he surrendered and stopped focusing on his handicap. But that's not all he had to do. He also had to appreciate the gift. The gift was that he could give it all to God and trust that God will work out for His glory. Paul was able to see how God's grace was sufficient even in an area where he was weak.

The good thing with surrendering to God is that it never goes to waste. This is because caring for you gives God great joy.

Prayer

Thank you, Jesus, for the gift of surrender. May I always know that when I am weak then I am strong. Open my eyes to see how your power is made perfect in my weakness.

SPEAK FAITH

1 Samuel 10:6 NIV

The Spirit of the Lord will come powerfully upon you, and you will prophesy with them; and you will be changed into a different person.

The words you declare will shape the change you see in your life. Declare that you are free and you will be free.

Maybe you struggle with speaking words that don't glorify God. Keep believing and declaring that you are the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus and that only holy words come out of your mouth.

As you do so, you create an atmosphere for the Holy Spirit to make a change in your life. This is because faith pleases God and makes Him roll up His sleeves and get to work.

Prayer

OBEDIENCE

Hebrews 5:8 AMP

Although He was a Son [who had never been disobedient to the Father], He learned [active, special] obedience through what He suffered.

Obedience is a virtue we have to embrace if we are going to be able to do big things for God. Many things don't take great faith, they take obedience.

God has a plan for your life. That plan is for you not to only be a nice person. He wants more for you. He wants His glory to be manifested in every area of your life.

It will take obedience for you to accept and become who God has called you to be. Just like Jesus let us let our sufferings teach us to trust and obey.

Philippians 4:12 NLT

The world tries to convince us that if everything in our day is not going at terrific speed then that's not a good day.

But God wants more for us than just getting what we want when we want it. He wants us to discover the freedom that comes from depending on Him for the joy and peace we need.

He wants us to be focused on Him and not on getting our own way. When we base our joy and peace on God, we can then be able to abound in every situation.

Making a difference is about loving your neighbor as yourself. Before you look so far, there are people around you who are in need and God has given you the ability to meet some of those needs.

In matter of fact, we don't get what we really deserve. Many ask how a loving God can let bad things happen. The real question we should ask though is how such a Holy and righteous God can even let us see any form of goodness even after seeing all our sin.

It's because He is slow to anger and abounding in mercy. His love is everlasting, and His mercies are new every morning, great is His faithfulness. He is not slack in His promises as some would count slackness, but He is slow to anger, not wanting anyone to perish.

Our only response can then be a life of deep gratitude and great reverence for Him. For He has put a new song in our mouths. From shame to glory, from ashes to beauty and from mourning to dancing.

God’s amazing grace and hope in His relentless love are the tools that enable us to live that life. His grace is the boat that carries us while our hope in His love is the anchor that holds us sure and steadfast. (Hebrews 6:19)

Saul failed to recognize even from the words the spirit spoke that it was not from God. This is because he did not know God's word. Saul should have realized that this was a demon the moment the spirit told him that God had become his enemy. This is because God can never become our enemy because He is love itself. We too should always be keen to discern God's voice from the rest. His words teach, rebuke, correct and train in righteousness.

That's why we should take time to read and meditate on the word of God. While the words of the enemy bring condemnation and death, God's words bring justification and life.

Psalms 103:2-3 NLT

Let all that I am praise the Lord; may I never forget the good things he does for me. He forgives all my sins and heals all my diseases.

One of the reasons God gives us grace is because He wants us to do the same for others. God is so extravagant with grace that it doesn't matter what you have done, the moment you come to Him, you can be sure of finding forgiveness.

The reason we struggle with giving others grace is because we forget how much we have been forgiven. If we could only see that we too are only where we are by God's grace, we would cover over a multitude of others' sins.

We have every reason to bless the Lord because we are forgiven for all our faults including those we haven't done yet. Nothing can ever separate us from God because our forgiveness was purchased by the precious blood of Jesus.

Hebrews 4:10 NIV

for anyone who enters God's rest also rests from their works, just as God did from his.

In Genesis 2:2, God finished the work he had been doing; so, on the seventh day he rested from all his work. Note that after He 'finished' He 'rested'.

The next time we hear of the word finished is later, when Jesus was on the cross. Knowing that He had won for us the victory, He said it is finished. Following the pattern from Genesis, what is left for us to do now is rest. That's why our theme verse invites us to enter this rest. We don't have to strive to attain God's promises. God wants us to have a response of rest to His word. Resting in the truth that His promises are sure and His word is alive and active in us.

Even when we fail to walk in this rest sometimes, we can still come to God's throne with confidence. This is because Jesus our high priest, understands our weakness and there is grace and mercy available for us at God's throne.

Prayer

Heavenly Father, thank you for finishing the work so I can rest. May I respond to your word with rest.

I DON'T WANT TO CONTROL, I WANT POWER

2 Corinthians 5:7 AMP

for we walk by faith, not by sight [living our lives in a manner consistent with our confident belief in God's promises]—

The opposite of walking in trust is living in control. The problem is that control is a cheap imitation of power. Many of us forfeit walking in real power because we are clinging so tightly to control.

The desire for control is created and fueled by fear. Seeking to be in control causes us to live in worry. As parents, we fear that our children will go astray, so we are anxious every time we don't know where they are. We worry about working enough hours so we can pay our bills and have enough to eat. But God is in control. If you want to walk through life in His power that requires trust. Trust in God's promise that He will perfect that which concerns you (Psalm 138:8). Trust in His unchangingness (Hebrews 13:8). Trust in His promise that all things work together for good to those who love the Lord and who are called according to His purpose (Romans 8:28).

Trust in His power that can do immeasurably more than you and I can ask or think (Ephesians 3:20-21). Trust in His mercies that are new every morning (Lamentations 3:22-23). Trust that He is doing something new (Isaiah 43:19).

Trying to be in control of everything is attractive, perhaps even easy. But God has not called us for easy. He has called us to walk in real power, the power of His Spirit, and real power is in the place of trust.

Prayer

Lord Jesus, thank you for your promise to give me power. May I not walk in fear but in faith. I will not live by what I see but by your unfailing promises.

THE GOD WHO IS NEVER UNDONE.

Ephesians 3:20 NIV

Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us,

There are two miracles in the Bible that have key similarities that we can draw from regarding how God is never undone. One is the story of the widow at Zarephath who fed Elijah with her last meal (1 Kings 17:8-16), and the other is the feeding of the 5000 (Mathew 14:15-21).

Some of the similarities from these stories are.

1. In both miracles, we see that God intervenes miraculously to save lives that are at the brink of perishing.
2. Even though both situations begin with extreme scarcity, they both end with overflowing abundance.
3. In both miracles, the people had to surrender the little they had to God and then watch as He multiplied it.
4. In both miracles, God proved Himself to be the God of more than enough.
5. Both miracles required stepping out into the unknown and simply trusting God.
6. In both, the insufficiency of the people did not limit God.

The same God who did these miracles is still at work today. He wants us to trust Him and watch how He will do far more than we thought was possible.

Prayer

Lord Jesus, thank you for you are working miracles in my life. I ask that you enable me to step out into the unknown, confident that you are the God of abundance.

LIVING IN FREEDOM AND PURPOSE

Luke 15:31-32 NIV

‘My son,’ the father said, ‘you are always with me, and everything I have is yours. But we had to celebrate and be glad, because this brother of yours was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found.’

In the story of the prodigal son, the older son who stayed with His father became angry because he didn’t know two things.

First was that he had access to all his father’s resources and therefore had no reason to envy or be jealous of things that were already his. Secondly, he now had another opportunity to honor his father by directing his younger brother in the right way. In the same way, we too worry and fret, forgetting that everything our Heavenly Father has also belongs to us. That includes peace, joy, love, mercy and grace among others.

Secondly, we now have an opportunity to honor God by showing others the way to pleasing God. When we walk in these two truths, then shall we live lives of freedom and purpose.

Prayer

YOUR ROLE IN GOD'S STORY

Matthew 6:9-10 NIV

“This, then, is how you should pray: ‘Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.

Our role in God's story is to lead others closer to Him. From the Lord's prayer, we get to see the part God wants us to play in His story.

Since it begins with "our," we should make it a priority not to have a mindset of self, but we should always consider others. Secondly, we should glorify the name of the Lord in all that we do. For example, when we work with excellence and integrity, we hallow God's Name.

Thirdly, we should bring God's kingdom, wherever we go. Through service, forgiveness, the words we speak, the things we watch, the way we dress among others. When we do these, we will be playing our role of leading others closer to the Father.

THE PROBLEM WITH COMPARISON.

Galatians 5:26 MSG

That means we will not compare ourselves with each other as if one of us were better and another worse. We have far more interesting things to do with our lives. Each of us is an original.

In the story of the prodigal son, the older son refused to attend his younger brother's party because he was chained by comparison (Luke 15:29-30).

He was envious that their father had thrown his younger brother a party, yet he had never made him one. What he didn't know was that his younger brother had reached a point of eating pig's food and yet no one could give it to him. On the other hand, the older brother was always provided for, but that's what comparison does. It makes it look like the grass is greener on the other side. Someone once said if the grass is greener, it's probably astroturf. Comparison keeps us from seeing how God has blessed us. It keeps us looking at the negative and ignoring all the good things in our lives. Comparison also makes us miss the point. Instead of being happy for the brother who was once lost, he just labelled him as a squanderer.

Comparison makes us see our colleagues as enemies. We should, therefore, take great care to avoid falling into the dangerous trap of comparison.

Prayer

Heavenly Father, help me to celebrate with others when they win. May I not be caught up in comparison.

THE GOD WHO NEVER GIVES UP

Luke 22:31-32 NLT

“Simon, Simon, Satan has asked to sift each of you like wheat. But I have pleaded in prayer for you, Simon, that your faith should not fail. So when you have repented and turned to me again, strengthen your brothers.”

God will stay with us even when we fall short of His glory. Peter failed in his endeavor to love Jesus sacrificially and yet Jesus' still gave him the assignment of taking care of His sheep.

God stays with us not because we deserve it but because of His grace. He does not wait for us to be perfect before He uses us. He perfects us along the way.

His eyes are not occupied with what's going on with you right now. He sees with eyes of faith and faith sees hope. That's why where others see failure, he sees victory, where others see despair, He sees hope and where others see a grave, He sees an empty tomb.

Prayer

Heavenly Father, thank you for always staying committed to me no matter what. I receive your love, forgiveness and strength.

A LIFE OF PURPOSE

Matthew 6:10 NLT

May your Kingdom come soon. May your will be done on earth, as it is in heaven.

When it came to purpose, I always wondered whether other people were walking in more purpose because of how successful they looked.

But God has been showing me that purpose for me is where He is. It is not about doing what I think is powerful but about obedience to His one step at a time leading.

Most of the time we focus on knowing what God's purpose for us is in our lives. But God wants us to pray a different prayer. He wants us to ask Him to mold us into the people who will fit into His purpose.

Prayer

Colossians 3:2-4 NASB

Wheel Alignment is the process of adjusting the angles of our vehicle's wheels to be perpendicular to the ground and parallel to each other.

In the same way, our spiritual lives should also be perpendicular to the ground — pointing upwards to God, not horizontally to people. There are several ways to realign our spiritual lives, including prayer, repenting our sinful behavior, worship time in church, reading God's word, and deep conversations with other accountable believers. When we're going astray or experiencing excessive vibrations in life, we can't just change the road or God's mind, but we can change how we travel by readjusting our lives into alignment with God's will and purpose.

Realigning to God's will gives us a sense of calm, clarity, and the ability to see light through a problem. By recasting the worries and fears of our problems to God's will, we become better equipped to face the adversity of the situation.

Prayer

Dear Lord Jesus, align me to your will. May I desire to be more like you and less like me. Fix my eyes on your purposes.

THE POWER OF OBEDIENCE

James 4:6 AMP

But He gives us more and more grace [through the power of the Holy Spirit to defy sin and live an obedient life that reflects both our faith and our gratitude for our salvation]. Therefore, it says, “God is opposed to the proud and haughty, but [continually] gives [the gift of] grace to the humble [who turn away from self-righteousness].

When feelings want to lead me astray, obedience keeps me on track. One time I will be feeling like “God give me your glory, I can take it.” And at another time I will be feeling like “Maybe You can hold on to your glory for now.” Feelings are so unstable, and we should never depend on them.

Whatever it is, going by your feelings will cause you to think that it is about you and what you want. But following the path of obedience will remind you that it’s all about Jesus and His purposes.

Hebrews 12:2 NIV

fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith. For the joy set before him he endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

One prayer we have to pray continually is that we may not lose sight of what truly matters. Many times, we forget that things like ministry or a spouse are not the end goal. Those should just be means to lead us to Jesus.

When we make those things our focus, we are like someone being so focused on a particular shoe that they want to wear to church that they give up on church altogether when they don't get that shoe. Many of us have become so focused on the things that are supposed to lead us to Christ, and we make them the end goal. It starts small until one day you realize you are so focused on ministry you forgot what you came for in the first place.

How you know this is when you are so focused on that thing being so perfect that you give it God's time too. This is why we have to ask God to keep us on track by reminding us of what we came for in the first place.

Psalms 23:4 NIV

From our theme verse, the only thing we should be confident in when in the valley is the fact that God is with us. Human strength will never do, only God will save us.

The money, spouse, abilities or friends will all fail us. God is the only one we can confidently lean on knowing He won't fail us. That's why He deserves all our worship and praise.

So, when we go through valleys, we need not fear, for our God is with us. He is the reason we will go through the fire and the storm and still come out victorious.

Prayer

Dear Lord Jesus, I will not fear when I go through deep waters for you are with me and you have got my back. May I not put my trust in human strength but in you alone.

CALLED TO REPRESENT

1 Peter 4:9 AMPC

Practice hospitality to one another (those of the household of faith). [Be hospitable, be a lover of strangers, with brotherly affection for the unknown guests, the foreigners, the poor, and all others who come your way who are of Christ's body.] And [in each instance] do it ungrudgingly (cordially and graciously, without complaining but as representing Him).

As children of God, we are called to represent Him wherever we are, in all situations. We might naturally not be inclined to being hospitable let alone do it without complaining. But out of the love we have for God we will be able to do so.

Some of the reasons for us to be hospitable include the truth that we could be welcoming angels unaware and the undeniable truth that we all need each other. But I think one other important reason is that we are heavenly ambassadors on earth. When we are hospitable without complaining we bring God's kingdom and thus walk in dominion.

We need the to trust in the Holy Spirit though to give us the patience, goodness and kindness we need to represent God to others.

MAKING ROOM

Luke 10:41-42 KJV

And Jesus answered and said unto her, Martha, Martha, thou art careful and troubled about many things: But one thing is needful: and Mary hath chosen that good part, which shall not be taken away from her.

The concept of making room for God is well illustrated by the picture of a man filling up a jar with stones of different sizes. He puts the big stones first because if he doesn't, he won't have space for them later.

The big stones for us children of God are prayer and the word of God. When we don't prioritize these above all else, we will find ourselves losing our center with every wind that comes our way. The problem with giving the smaller stones such as ministry first place is that we miss out on the wedding feast prepared for us just like the guests in Mathew 22:1-10.

The godly way to do ministry is to do it with an aim of creating room for God. God desires the best for us, and He knows that we are receiving the best when we are with Him.

LOVE IS THE GREATEST

I Corinthians 13:8 NKJV

Love never fails. But whether there are prophecies, they will fail; whether there are tongues, they will cease; whether there is knowledge, it will vanish away.

As Christians, we can never say things like "I was never meant to love that person." Just like you can predetermine to have a good day no matter what happens, you can also predetermine to love others no matter what they do.

That's why Job 22:24-25 AMP says, "And place your gold in the dust, And the gold of Ophir among the stones of the brooks [considering it of little value] And make the Almighty your gold and your precious silver." Everything else has to pale in comparison with our God. We should be willing to let go of anything for God. It might not even be a sinful thing but if you love it more than God, then it has turned into an idol.

God wants us to reach a level where even when we don't get the thing we want, we are okay if we have Him. When God sees that you have reached that level, then He knows you are ready to receive that thing because even when you get it, your devotion will still be on Him.

Prayer

Dear Lord Jesus, you are all I want. Nothing else compares to you. Help me lay it all down so that I can have You.

LIVE FOR JESUS

II Corinthians 5:15 NKJV

and He died for all, that those who live should live no longer for themselves, but for Him who died for them and rose again.

Our verse first speaks of the truth that Jesus died for all. A reminder for us to share the good news that people don't have to go to hell for sins that were already paid for.

The truth that He paid for us doesn't give us a license to sin but rather teaches us to deny ungodliness and worldly lusts and live righteously, soberly and godly in this present world. We can deny ungodliness because when Jesus defeated death, He also removed it's sting which is sin (1 Corinthians 15:55-56). It may be true that just like me, what you want to do is not what you do, but thanks be to God who gives us the victory through Jesus Christ our Lord. We can overcome sin because it no longer has dominion over us for, we now live under grace, God's divine enablement. (Romans 6:14)

Jesus is worthy of us living for Him after all how can we neglect such a great salvation that He paid for us with His very life.

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Prayer

Dear Lord Jesus, thank you for paying the price I couldn't pay. May I live for You for you are worthy of it all.

JESUS PAID FOR ME

Galatians 5:1 NIV

It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery.

Not walking in the freedom Jesus paid for us to have is like suffering financially yet your bank account has a lot of money that you are not using.

Jesus paid for us, so that we can now walk in peace, joy, love, patience, faithfulness, goodness, gentleness, kindness and self-control. We can now walk in faith and boldness, abounding always not in our strength but in the strength of the Lord. When someone asks you how you are able to do it, you answer by telling them 'Jesus paid'.

Whatever difficulty you may encounter, know that you are able to overcome because Jesus did what had to be done for you to be victorious.

TRUE LOVE

1 Corinthians 13:4 NIV

Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud.

One virtue that we must receive and give others is love. While tongues, prophecy and faith are good virtues, they cannot be compared with love. Love is on a whole other level.

Sadly, many people never get to receive or give true love. This is the kind of love described in 1 Corinthians 13. It's love that doesn't depend on the other person's qualities. Loving others based on their qualities is shaky ground. This is because qualities change. Instead, love someone because you have chosen to love them regardless. Whether they change or not, you will still love them. That's how Jesus loved us and how we ought to love others.

We can only give this love to others out of the overflow of the love we ourselves have received from Jesus.

1 Corinthians 4:7 NIV

For who makes you different from anyone else? What do you have that you did not receive? And if you did receive it, why do you boast as though you did not?

First of all, the differences are gifts, and they are no reason for us to boast because they were just given to us. Pride causes us to think that our differences make us better than others.

Secondly, the differences are necessary. You only realize that the moon's dimness is good for the night when compared with the sun's brightness. We should not shun others because of how different they are. The differences are part of God's design. Thirdly, there is no difference between us. God is the father to all of us regardless of how we differ. What really matters is who our Lord is.

Differences don't make us incompatible; they help fulfill the different purposes God has for us.

II Corinthians 10:4 NKJV

The enemy would want to convince us that the tools we have are weak and that they have no use whatsoever. We can truly appreciate the power of these weapons only when we put them to use. A friend testified to me recently that she accepted Christ because of how a Christian showed her kindness.

The challenge to all of us is to put these powerful weapons to use and see what God can do.

2 Corinthians 3:2

You yourselves are our letter, written on our hearts, known and read by everyone.

For many people the only Bible they will ever read is you. That's why you should not only shine but also let others know who is making you shine.

Jesus put it like this, 'No one lights a lamp and then puts it under a basket. Instead, a lamp is placed on a stand, where it gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way let your good deeds shine for all to see, so that everyone will praise your heavenly Father.' (Mathew 5:15-16). Luke 10:38-39 NIV
